

Self-directed Support

Self-directed Support gives everyone who needs social care services or support the opportunity to lead the life they choose within their own home and community, including children, adults and unpaid carers.

Option 1

You receive the funds (Direct Payment) to buy support yourself

Option 2

You choose the support you would like and it is arranged for you

Option 3

The Health and Social Care Partnership arrange support on your behalf

Option 4

A combination of Option 1, 2 or 3



Self-directed Support Service


The SDS team work across Dundee & Angus providing advice and guidance to disabled people and carers who are going through the SDS process. We can help you to understand your options and provide you with information so you can make an informed choice.

If you choose **Option 1**, (**Direct Payment**) we can help you with:

- Navigating the Direct Payment process
- Recruitment and selection
- Setting up as an employer
- Budgeting and calculating rates of pay
- Financial monitoring

If you choose one of the other Options, we can provide you with advice and guidance and signposting.





Carers Budgets

Since the Carers (Scotland) Act 2016 was introduced, unpaid carers have the right to request an Adult Carer Support Plan or a Young Carers Statement. This plan allows you to think about what support you want and need in order to continue in your caring role.

If you are eligible, you may receive a Carers Budget in the form of a Direct Payment (Option 1), or be offered replacement care for the person you support through one of the 4 SDS Options.

SDS Advisors can support you with deciding which option works best for you and how to use your Carers Budget.

How do I request an Adult Carer Support Plan or Young Carers Statement?

If the person you care for is already receiving support, you can ask their Social Worker or Case Manager to complete an Adult Carer Support Plan or Young Carers Statement with you.

Payroll Service

Dundee Carers Centre also has a Payroll Service for people who choose Option 1 (Direct Payment) to employ their own Personal Assistants and would like some support with managing payments.

The Payroll team are happy to discuss tailoring the service to your needs, but usually offer three levels of support to choose from:

- Basic Payroll Service
- Intermediate Support Service
- Third Party Money Management Service
